May and June 1807. -- *Siege of Colberg.*

19 June. Lieutenant MERKEL (died of his wounds).
22 June. Lieutenant von HENNING II (died of his wounds).
-- Wounded during the siege: Colonel von HENNING and two lieutenants.

4 and 5 August 1809. -- *Combats of Unter-Au and of Ober-Au (Tyrol).*

Colonel von HENNING (died of his wounds).
Captain von HÖNNING (killed).
Captain A. von SCHIRBRANDT (killed).
Lieutenant von SCHIRBRANDT (killed).
Lieutenant von HÖNNING (killed).
Lieutenant von BREUN (died of his wounds).
-- Wounded: 3 senior officers, 3 captains, 10 lieutenants and 1 surgeon.

25 March 1810. -- *Combat of Manresa (Spain).*

Captain GEYER von GEYERSBERG (died of his wounds)
--Wounded: 2 captains, 7 lieutenants.

18 July 1810. -- *Combat of Granollers (Spain).*

Lieutenant MULLER (died of his wounds).

5 December 1812. -- *On the route of Smorgoni.*

7 December 1812. -- *in Lithuania.*

Lieutenant ALTROCK (killed with the outposts).

10 DECEMBER 1812. — *Combat of Vilnius.*

Captain SCHULTHES (wounded and died in captivity).

Lieutenant von WAGENHEIM (killed).

Lieutenant FRIEDHEIM (wounded and died in captivity).

Lieutenant von STEUBEN (wounded and died in captivity).

Lieutenant von KROPF (wounded and died in captivity).

Lieutenant von KINSKI (wounded and died in captivity).

Lieutenant von DIEMAR (wounded and died in captivity).

Lieutenant von BACHOF (wounded and died in captivity).

Lieutenant von KURNATOWSKI (wounded and died in captivity).

Captain von CRAYEN (wounded and died 14 March 1813).

-- Wounded: 2 captains, 4 lieutenants.
