


The Napoleon Series

We are pleased to announce a new collaboration between the Napoleon Series and the publishers Helion & Co.



Recent discussions on the Napoleon Series forum have indicated that a number of contributors are interested in making the jump to publishing their work in hard copy but are not necessarily yet at the stage where they are ready to venture a full-length book.

Equally, other contributors may have offshoots of research that are too short for a book but too long for, or unsuited to the format of, an article either on the Napoleon Series or in a print journal.

Submissions are therefore requested from anyone interested in submitting a proposal for a chapter, or between eight and twelve thousand words, for a multi-authored work covering the Napoleonic Wars in Europe, 1803-1814. We are deliberately excluding the French Revolutionary Wars, the war at sea and overseas, the Peninsular War, and the Hundred Days as these topics could all form the basis of future titles in the same format if this one is a success (it is accepted that some chapters may need to touch on these areas as part of their coverage, but they should not be the main topic). Chapters could focus on an individual, a battle or campaign, a regiment or other unit, or any other aspect of the military history of the era. Chapters should consist primarily of material that has not previously appeared in print.

The finished book will be published in late 2019 as part of Helion's '[From Reason to Revolution 1721-1815](#)' Series and will be edited by series editor Andrew Bamford.

Anyone interested in contributing should submit a proposal of c.500 words, outlining their intended topic, to andrewbamford18@gmail.com. The deadline for submitting a proposal is 1 June 2018 and the final list of contributors will be notified as soon after that date as possible. The deadline for submitting the finished chapters will be summer 2019; an exact date will be confirmed closer to the time.

All contributors will receive a copy of the published book and £100 in Helion book vouchers.

In due course it is hoped to arrange a discount to enable the finished book to be purchased at a discount via the Napoleon Series.
